



## **Summary of Selected Findings**

- 1. A majority in St. Kitts & Nevis, as in Trinidad & Tobago, identify security as the most important problem in their countries
- 2. Neighborhood insecurity is low in the OECS compared to the rest of the Americas
  - "Young adults, less wealthy people, and women report higher levels of insecurity
- 3. Around 1 in 10 people report crime victimization in the past year in Saint Lucia and in Dominica
- 4. Reports of illegal drug sales in one's neighborhood are comparatively high in Dominica and St. Lucia
- 1 in 6 people report murders in their neighborhood in St. Kitts & Nevis and in Trinidad & Tobago










