These special surveys were carried out in three consecutive years, from 1998 to 2000, by the Latin America Public Opinion Project (LAPOP). The database accumulated across these three surveys allows for an examination of the impact of the DDPC (Democracy Development and Citizen Participation) program in Bolivia. They were conducted by the University of Pittsburgh and Encuestas y Estudios under the direction of Dr. Luis Quiroga. This study was funded by a grant from the United States Agency for International Development (USAID).

The 1998 and 2000 DDPC Program datasets were run as oversamples of the “The Political Culture of Democracy in Bolivia 1998” and “The Political Culture of Democracy in Bolivia 2000” surveys, respectively. The 1999 DDPC Program survey was carried out on its own. The 1998 DDPC
